Accuplacer, College Level Math (CLM), Levels of English Proficiency (LOEP), please call the Testing Center at 973-328-5166 or go online at www.ccm. edu; you will need your Student Identification Number from your admissions letter. Sample test questions for mathematics and algebra are available for review on the Testing Center's webpage.

When a student's course of interest includes a placement test prerequisite, they may satisfy the requirement through submitting an SAT or ACT score in that area, i.e., SAT Critical Reading score of 540 or ACT English score 23 for the English portion of the placement test; SAT Math score of 530 or ACT Math score of 23 for the math portion of the placement test. If applicable, please include a copy of such scores with your Challenger Application.

- 3) Be sure to note that some advanced courses require additional assessment testing, department waivers or preliminary course completion before registration.
- 4) Students who are age 15 or younger need to have their Challenger Registration Forms signed by the appropriate CCM Academic Deans or Department Chairpersons. Please plan to fulfill this provision early by contacting:

- 5) Using the Challenger Registration Form with all requisite signatures, students may register either through the mail, via fax or in person, but not online. Mailed and faxed forms, however, must be received before the Payment Due Date; see WebAdvisor link in the Quicklinks box, www.ccm.edu. Mailed registration forms should be sent to the Admissions Office and faxed forms to the Records and Registration Office, 973-328-5209. Registration on or after the Payment Due Date may only be done in person through the Records and Registration Office, Student Community Center, parking lot 6; payment is due the same day to the Bursar's Office. Tuition bills are available online only through WebAdvisor.
- 6) Lastly, it is strongly advisable to identify alternate choices on the Challenger Registration Form. And, please be aware that extra fees are assessed for late payment and withdrawal.



**Welcome to the Challenger Program** 

The Challenger Program provides high school students the opportunity to enrich their education through *college-level* coursework at the County College of Morris. In addition to credit-bearing courses, students may enroll in *ESL* (*English for Speakers of Other Languages*) courses. Enrollment in developmental (remedial) English and math courses, however, is not permitted, despite any placement test results.

This brochure contains the Challenger Program Application and Registration Form, including the enrollment procedures. This information, including the Course Schedule (see Quicklinks box), is also available online, www.ccm.edu. Please read the following Admissions and Course Registration Procedures carefully, noting that high school students may neither apply nor register online.

Because Challenger students enroll on a non-matriculated (non-degree) basis, they are ineligible for financial aid. However, continuing students with a grade point average of 3.0 or higher in previous credit coursework are eligible to apply for the Solix Scholarship through the Financial Aid Office; please call 973-328-5230 for information.

## **Application and Course Registration Procedures**

- 1) All *first-time* students who are new to the Challenger Program must submit the completed Challenger Application and application fee to the CCM Admissions Office. Students who have a Permanent Residency Card or a Visa must bring their original document to the Admissions Office; copies are not acceptable. Upon receipt of these materials, students will receive a confirmation letter containing their *Student Identification #.* (*Continuing* students are exempt from re-applying and need only follow the registration procedures.)
- 2) Again, only college-level courses, including ESL, may be taken through the Challenger Program; enrollment in remedial courses is not permitted. Before submitting the *Challenger Course Registration Form*, please read the online descriptions of the courses you are considering. Some have prerequisites which must be satisfied prior to registration. For example, English, mathematics, and most science courses require the college's *placement test Accuplacer*. Many courses, however, do not have any prerequisites. To schedule required tests, e.g.,
