Community Service

Lenape Valley Regional High School offers students the opportunity to earn 2.5 credits by completing community service.

Service Guidelines

- In order to earn 2.5 credits students must complete and document 40 hours of community service.
- A grade of Pass/Fail will be awarded on the transcript. These credits will not factor into the Grade Point Average.
- Service should be completed with a community organization
- Some Lenape Valley classes, activities and athletic programs provide opportunities to complete service hours
- Additional service opportunities are emailed to students when available and a list of service organizations can be found on the Guidance website under the *All Students* tab.
- Service may not be done for family members, for profit companies or financial gain.
- School service must be logged and verified by the student using the Community Service Documentation form found on the Guidance website under the *All Students* tab.
