## Community Service

## Service Guidelines

- •A grade of Pass/Fail will be awarded on the transcript. These credits will not factor into the Grade Point Average.
- •Service should be completed with a community organization
- •Some Lenape Valley classes, activities and athletic programs provide opportunities to complete service hours

- •Service may not be done for family members, for profit companies or financial gain.
- •School service must be logged and verified by the student using the Community Service Documentation form found on the Guidance website under the *All Students* tab.
